School Arrival Screening Procedures:

ALL students will be screened upon arrival at school.

Students arriving by car will have temperature checked and asked a series of screening questions prior to getting out of their vehicle. If students have a temperature above 100 and/or answers to screening questions do not meet CDC requirements, they will have to go home.

Students arriving by bus will have temperature checked and asked a series of screening questions as they exit the bus. If students have a temperature above 100 and/or answers to screening questions do not meet CDC requirements, they will have to go home. Parents will be called to come and get their child.

Students walking or riding bike to school will be met by a staff member at various outdoor locations of our campus. Students will have temperature checked and asked a series of screening questions as they arrive. If students have a temperature above 100 and/or answers to screening questions do not meet CDC requirements, they will have to go home.

Students who come to school and get sick or have symptoms will be escorted to an isolation room where they will wait for a parent to pick them up.

We will have staff around the building helping to get all students (new and returning students) to their classes each morning.
